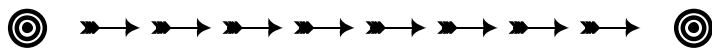

We hope you are well. Here's hoping that the worst of the winter weather is behind us, and that we can look forward to lighter and warmer days.

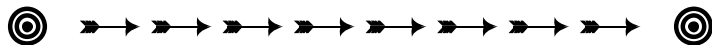
